
Voucher Impacts on Student Outcomes As Harmful as Natural Disasters (Measured in Standard Deviation)

The Nation's Education Agenda

Survey of 1,502 registered voters nationwide, including 558 public school parents and 1,323 2022 voters, conducted December 12 to 17, 2022



KEY POINT:

When voters and parents prioritize their goals for schools today, they emphasize the building blocks of student success: strong fundamental skills, and critical reasoning skills, practical life skills. And they want schools to provide a safe and welcoming environment for children and ensure an opportunity for all children to succeed.

The goals emphasized by "culture warriors" are at the bottom of the list.

By a lopsided margin, voters and parents want policymakers to focus on improving education in the public schools rather than giving parents more choice of schools.
